resound through	be heard throughout some place	
manor house	the house of a lord of a manor (mansion)	
lush	characterised by luxuriant vegetation	
sumptuously	of a size or splendor suggesting great expense	
crowbar	a straight bar of iron or steel, with the working end shaped like a chisel and often slightly bent and forked, used as a lever.	
assailant	a person who attacks another.	
ajar	partially opened	
dial	the face of a clock	
skein	a length of thread or yarn wound in a loose long coil.	
(planting) hoe	a tool with a flat blade attached approximately at a right angle to a long handle, used for weeding, cultivating, and gardening	
forensics	the use of science and technology to investigate and establish facts in criminal or civil courts of law.	
prime suspect	one who is suspected, especially of having committed a crime.	
glacial	lacking warmth and friendliness	
insightful	Showing or having insight (capacity for understanding another's mental processes)
